Bukan penulis pertama, tidak ditemukan pelanggaran ilmiah. Terlihat keselarasan antara IMRAD. Pembahasan substansi kurang memadai, dukungan pustaka sangaat kurang karena hanya didukung pustaka primer mutakhir 3 dari 4 referensi yang ada. Kelengkapan unsur dan kualitas penerbit baik. Ada informasi proses *submitted-received-revised-accepted* > 3 bulan.

### SPECIFICATION TABLE

Functions as a metadata table. By reading the information provided here others should be able to reuse, reproduce or replicate your data.  
(Refer to the [template](#) for more instructions.)



### VALUE OF DATA

In brief bullet points explain the value of your dataset, avoiding novelty claims and vague statements:

- Why are your data useful or important to the research community?
- Who can use/benefit from the data?
- How can the data be (re)used for further insights or analysis?



### DATA DESCRIPTION

✓ Briefly, describe and refer to each **data file** included in the article and supplementary files or in the repository.  
✗ Do **not** include any background, insights or interpretation.  
✓ All data including supplementary files, or files deposited on a repository must be shared in an **open format** that is easily accessible to most people who may reuse the data.  
No word limit.



### EXPERIMENTAL DESIGN, MATERIAL AND METHODS

Provide a detailed description of how the data were acquired and analysed. Aid data reproduction and reuse by offering a more comprehensive description than any related article or previous articles.  
No word limit.
